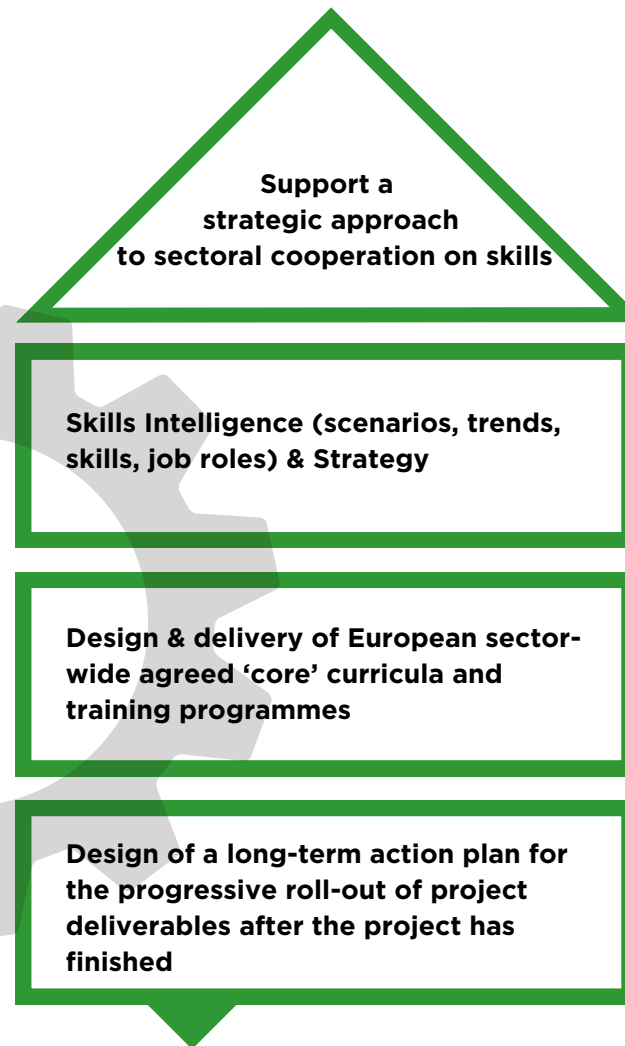
Context
